Each Tug Team contributes a \$1,000 entry fee, with funds raised through TUG for TOTS put to immediate use. TUG has raised over \$435,000 since its inception and all contributions assist local children!

YOUR DONATIONS IN ACTION

Thanks to your generosity, CHIP enrolled children and their families will receive qualified education and guidance for all of the following!

OVERALL PHYSICAL HEALTH

CHIP establishes a medical home for newly enrolled children, communicates with doctors and reviews medical records to ensure each child meets immunization schedules and developmental milestones

ORAL HEALTH

CHIP connects each enrolled child to a dental home and applies fluoride varnishes from 9 months to 36 months to optimize their oral health and hosts Dental Days to provide in-kind dental screenings



HEALTH LITERACY AND EDUCATION

Educating parents to increase health literacy and communicate more effectively with doctors

TRANSPORTATION

CHIP provides more than 400 transports annually to appointments (with doctors, dentists, etc.)

FAMILY SELF-SUFFICIENCY

CHIP caregivers are encouraged to establish goals and linkages with community resources, further parental education levels and maintain their child's developmental and literacy achievement to promote school readiness



ASTHMA

CHIP nurses provide monthly home visits designed to complement the primary care provider or pulmonologist care an asthmatic child receives

PRENATAL & POSTPARTUM CARE

CHIP nurses work with expectant mothers of all ages to promote optimal birth weight, decreased infant mortality, stopping or reducing high risk behaviors including smoking

MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELING

CHIP's Licensed Clinical Social Worker provides play therapy for enrolled children and therapeutic counseling for caretakers of CHIP children in CHIP's Counseling Center
